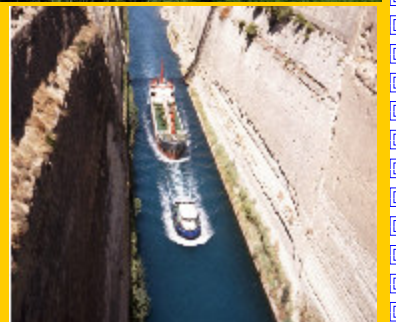
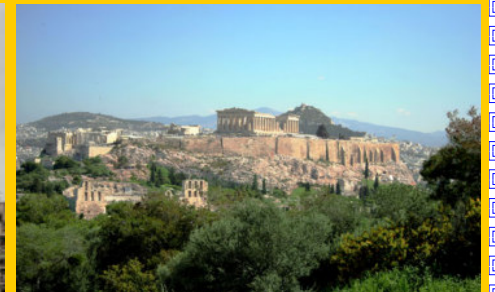

## TURKEY, GREECE, AND ITALY

**MAY 21: DEPART CHICAGO** Board our overnight flight, we are off on the adventure of a lifetime to Istanbul, Turkey.

**MAY 22: ISTANBUL, TURKEY** Upon arrival in Istanbul, Turkey's largest city, your guide will meet you and you will proceed to discover the city Istanbul, visit Church of Chora and Spice Market. Return to the airport for your flight to ANTAKYA. Transfer to your hotel for Dinner and overnight.

**MAY 23: ANTAKYA/ TARSUS/ CAPPADOCIA** This morning visit Antakya, it was the home of several **Roman temples** and its suburb, Daphne, was held to be the very place where Daphne was turned into a laurel tree to escape the affections of Apollo. Drive this afternoon to Tarsus the hometown of the apostle Paul, a city of great importance as a learning center of the ancient world, alongside Alexandria and Athens. Visit the excavations that have turned up a paved city street along with a colonnaded podium, which may date to the 2nd century B.C. Visit the remains that have been found from the Bronze Age, baths, a Hellenistic portico, and a Roman theater. Proceed to Cappadocia for dinner and overnight.

**MAY 24: CAPPADOCIA** Start out early for a full day's excursion into the magical lunarscape of Cappadocia's rocky hills & valleys. Dominated by Erciyes Dagi, Mt. Argaeus, the region was first settled by ancient people then home to Romans, early Christians, Byzantines and Seljuks. Visit **Goreme Church Valley, Zelve, Avanos, Ortahisar and Uchisar**, and see some of the many churches carved into the rocks. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

**MAY 25: KONYA/ PSIDIAN/ ANTIOCH/ PAMUKKALE** *Paul turned to the Gentiles:* This morning depart from Cappadocia drive thru central Anatolian plateau to Konya (Iconium) where Paul visited on his first journey and Lystra where Paul was stoned, as well as nearby Derbe. Continue to Psidian Antioch (Yalvac) and visit the temple of Augustus who was regarded as the city's founder, this temple dedicated to him was built after 2 B.C. and became the focal point of the city. St. Paul had visited Perga on the Mediterranean Coast his first missionary journey, where John and Mark left them to Paul's disappointment. Paul and Barnabas had continued to Taurus Mountains and reached to Psidian Antioch in north. Following your visit continue over the Lakes district to Pamukkale for Dinner and overnight.

**MAY 26: PAMUKKALE- HIERAPOLIS- LAODICEA- MILETUS- KUSADASI HIERAPOLIS, THE SACRED CITY:** In the first century it was part of the tri-city area of Laodicea, Colossae, and Hierapolis. Visit the Byzantine street and Gate, The Apollo Temple, and the city's theater which stands in the background. Visit the well-preserved Necropolis that contains sarcophagi, many different types of tombs, and funeral monuments dating from the Hellenistic until the early Christian times. Continue to Laodicea located in the Lycus River Valley. Visit the "Ephesian Gate" This triple-arched gateway. Afterwards drive to Miletus and see the Roman Baths, Roman fountains, grand theater building. Continue to Sardes to visit Artemis Temple, restored Synagogue, and Gymnasium. Proceed to your hotel in Kusadasi for dinner and overnight. Afterwards continue to Kusadasi for Dinner and overnight.

**MAY 27: KUSADASI/ EPHEBUS/ DIKILI** Our scenic drive from Kusadasi brings us to the basilica of St. John, built on the hilltop site of the house and tomb of St. John the Apostle. Here lies the crypt with the tomb of St. John. The highlight of our day will be our visit to Ephesus where St. Paul visited Ephesus between AD 55-58 (Acts 19). In addition to Saints John and Paul, Ephesus was also the home to the mother of Christ. We'll make a visit to the Chapel of the Virgin Mary, the most important Christian shrine in Ephesus. Continue to Izmir (Smyrna) for dinner and overnight hotel stay.

**MAY 28: IZMIR/ PERGAMUM/ ASSOS/ TROAS/ CANAKKALE** Drive thru plateau to Pergamum where parchment paper was invented, the treasury of the Alexander Great had enriched the city, it was the center of art and culture. First visit the Acropolis, view the city from Citadel see the city walls, Trajan Temple, the most steep Theater, the remains of Zeus Altar which was known as the Throne of Satan. Drive north to Assos along the ancient path where Paul walked with his companions. See the remains of the ancient Roman Road which stretch from Troas to Assos. See the ancient city and view the Greek Isle of Lesbos (Mittilini) at a distance. Continue to Alexander Troas where Paul had sailed to Philippi. See the old harbor and the city walls. Dinner and overnight in Canakkale.

**MAY 29: CANAKKALE / KAVALA, GREECE** Cross Dardanelis strait from Asia to Europe, drive thru the Gallipoli War 1915 battlefields over Gallipoli and Kesan. Reach to Greek Border at noon and cross into Greece. Continue into the modern port city of Kavala, ancient Neapolis, where Paul accompanied by Silas, Luke and Timothy, first set foot in Europe. Aside from the great panoramas of Kavala, the city has a Byzantine castle, and aqueduct. *Dinner and overnight in Kavala.*

**MAY 30: KAVALA/ PHILIPPI/ THESSALONIKI** Tour Philippi, where Paul delivered his first sermon in Europe, sowing the seeds of Christianity. Here Paul baptized "a certain woman named Lydia" the first Christian convert in Europe. The Roman Forum, completely excavated, is from after Paul's time. Among the ruins, located on the rocky ledge above the town's main road, is the "prison" where Paul and Silas were thrown. In the rocks you will find inscriptions and carved reliefs of deities. It was in Philippi that Octavian and Antony defeated Brutus and Cassius, last defenders of the Roman Republic in 42 BC. Continue to Thessaloniki, the former capital of Macedonia. See the ramparts of the city, the Triumphal Arch of Galerius straddling the Via Egnatia. *Dinner and overnight in Thessaloniki.*

**MAY 31: THESSALONIKI/ VERIA/ ATHENS** Enjoy this morning a city tour of Thessaloniki where, Paul preached during the winters of 49-50 AD and wrote two epistles to the ancient Thessalonians. See the ramparts of the city, the triumphal Arch of Galerius straddling the Via Egnatia, once a strategic artery of the Roman Empire. Drive to Athens with a stop at Levadia. Drive to your hotel. *Dinner and overnight in Athens.*

**JUN 01: ATHENS** Morning city sightseeing of Athens which will include a visit to the world renowned Acropolis, with the ruins of the Parthenon, Erectheum and Propylea. Thereafter we will ascend Mars Hill, where Paul preached. Also, visit the Agora (ancient market place, and former center of Athenian public life), the House of Parliament, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and the Palace, now called the Presidential Palace. Return to your hotel for the balance of the day at leisure. *Dinner and overnight in Athens.*

**JUN 02: ATHENS/ CORINTH/ ROME** Depart this morning for a sightseeing tour of ancient Corinth, seeing the Archaeological Museum, the Bema, and the Market Place and Temples. Corinth was home to St. Paul for 18 months. From the Bema at Corinth, Paul spoke to the Corinthians about Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. On the way to Corinth, we will stop for a few minutes at the Corinth Canal, which separates Peloponnese from the Greek Mainland and connects the two Seas (Ionian and Aegean). Return to Athens International airport for your flight to Rome. **AZ 721 @ 7:25PM arriving Rome @ 8:40PM.** Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to your hotel. (Dinner will be served on the flight) *Overnight in Rome.*

**JUN 03: ROME, THE ETERNAL CITY** This morning enjoy a city tour of Rome. Visit the Vatican Museums with the Sistine Chapel and Michaelangelo's frescoes, St. Peter's Basilica. Visit the Coliseum, the Forum and the Mamertine Prison. Return to your hotel. *Dinner and overnight in Rome.*

**JUN 04: ROME** After breakfast, in the morning tour some of the city's past splendor and pass by legendary monuments, palaces, ruins, squares and fountains. You will also visit the Catacombs of Santa Domitilla where the early Christians held their forbidden services and buried their dead. Drive to visit The Basilica of St Paul Outside the Walls which was founded by the Roman Emperor Constantine I over what was believed to be the burial place of Saint Paul. Continue to visit the Church of St. Paul of the Three Fountains, located just outside Rome. It is said to be built on the spot where St. Paul was beheaded by order of Nero. *Dinner and overnight in Rome.*

**JUN 05: ROME / POMPEY / ROME** After breakfast, depart Rome to Pompey, a haven for many wealthy Romans, and so the rich remains hold a certain fascination for us today. Many of the frescos still seem fresh, and the restored mosaic floors are spectacular. Over two millennia ago people were living in houses and apartments of a type that we wouldn't mind living in today. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

**JUN 06: ROME/ CHICAGO** Transfer to Rome International Airport for your return flight to Chicago, arriving in the afternoon local time.
